Dear Parents and Carers

We are writing to inform you that, due to rising costs, there will be a price increase for extended services sessions from September 2023.

The cost of a breakfast club session will increase to £5.

The cost of an after school club session will increase to £7 for a half session (up to 4.30pm) and £10 for a full session (up to 6pm).

In addition, from September 2023, the cost of a school meal will increase to £2.50. If you receive one of the following benefits you may be eligible to apply for Pupil Premium funding, and this will enable your child to receive free school meals.

- Universal Credit with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income-Based Jobseekers' Allowance
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, **not** entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Income Support
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' – the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work
